- There are significant economic, social and environmental benefits in taking action to combat and prepare for climate change.

- The UK Climate Change Programmes and targets for the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions.

Internal Actions:

- Ensure that greenhouse gas reduction and climate change adaptation measures are clearly incorporated into our association's own existing and new strategies, plans and programmes, in line with sustainable development principles.
- Inform member companies of the association's climate change response, detailing actions taken, outcomes achieved and further actions required

External Actions:

- Support our sector and members in their assessment of the risks and opportunities arising from the impacts of expected climate change, and help members to adapt accordingly.
- Encourage and work with our sector and members to reduce their greenhouse gas emissions and to make public their commitment to action.
- Collaborate with other organisations to promote good practice on climate change mitigation and adaptation.

- Work with UK Government to contribute to the delivery of the UK's Climate Change Programmes, including to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and to adapt to future climate change.

acknowledges the increasing impact that climate change will have on our country and other countries during the 21st Century and commits to tackling the causes and effects of a changing climate within our sector.

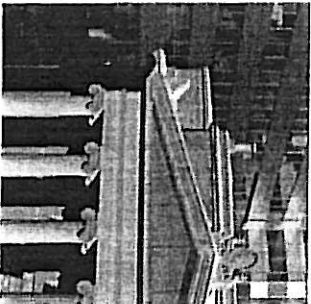
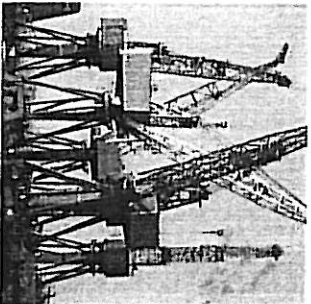
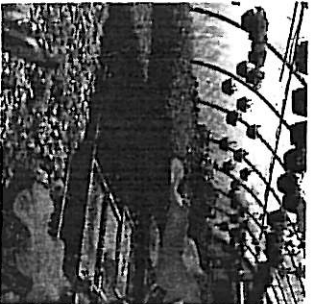
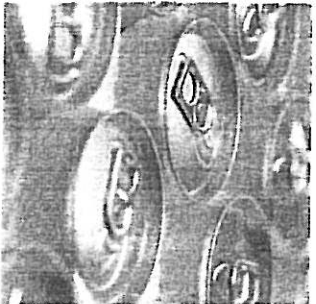
